THE MUSKETAWA TRAIL

The Musketawa Trail runs 25 miles from Muskegon to Marne. Explore farmland, wetlands and creeks along this paved, multi use trail.

HERITAGE LANDING

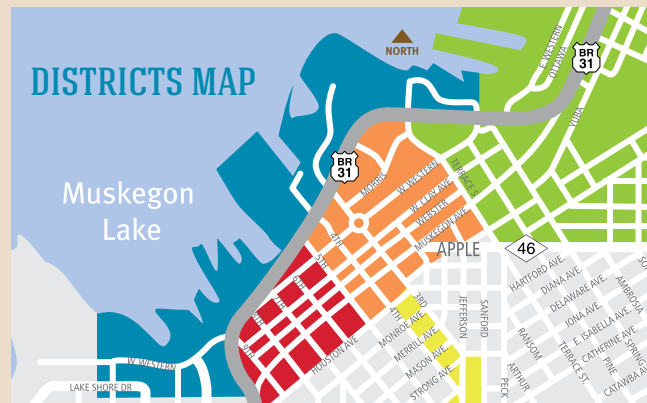
